LOCATION: MARKET SQUARE ANSWER: THE OLD STOCKS - 1859
2. Every year on a Sunday in November we stand here to pay our respects. What sits on top of my pillar?
LOCATION: MARKET SQUARE WAR MEMORIAL ANSWER: A CROSS
3. Since Tudor times I have been used for many things - I used to be a store of books for people to borrow, now I house officers who represent our town. What days & hours am I open?
LOCATION: THE OLD LIBRARY ANSWER: MON, TUES, THURS 10AM - 12NOON
4. This Celtic saint's house has people who look after your teeth. How many golden plaques are displayed by my door?
LOCATION: ST OSWALDS DENTAL PRACTICE ANSWER: 6
5. I used to sell bread but now I sell tasty Eastern food -but the sign of my bakery still sits above my windows. What does it say?
LOCATION: HONG KONG KITCHEN CHINESE ANSWER: HOVIS SIGN
6. A blue plaque by the door of this provider of food and wine tells how a famous science fiction writer used to live at this address? What years did he live here?
LOCATION: OLIVE & VINE RESTAURANT ANSWER: H G WELLS 1883-1884
7. Above the shop that sells all you need for horses and outdoors sit the picture of a former Queen and Empress. How many countries are listed around her portrait (list them)?
LOCATION: STOCKLEYS ANSWER: QUEEN VICTORIA - 13: GREAT BRITAIN & IRELAND, CANADA, AUSTRALIA, NEW ZEALAN, BURMAH, EGYPT, CYPRESS, MALTA, GIBRALTA, AFRICA, WEST INDIES, INDIA.
8. Tired and thirsty horses could once drink from here - but now it is full of pebbles. What words are written on my side?
LOCATION: PELICAN CROSSING BY NORTH STREET CAR PARK. ANSWER: OLD WATER TROUGH
9. Before mobile phones we used to use this to make a call. What am I used for now?
LOCATION: ON PAVEMENT NEXT TO THE BAKERY ANSWER: OLD RED TELEPHONE BOX - NOW USED FOR INFORMATION
10. This former school hall of learning has some Latin words inscribed above its entrance. What are they?
LOCATION: MEMORIAL HALL, SDNP ANSWER: SCOLA GRAMMATICIS
