Her linebased paintings, inspired by colloquial life in the West Sussex countryside and Euro-pean cities such as Nice. evoke a colourful and uplifting atmosphere. Lesley works with acrylic paint as it offers vibrancy and versatility as a medium, whilst reflecting the sense of precision which is clear in her work. Her art uses life experiences or photographs for inspiration, which then form the subject of her paintings. She transforms everyday places such as local pubs and cafes and uses her observations of everyday life to capture an abstracted depiction. Lesley's work celebrates the material quality of paint, so viewers can see the colour and vibrancy of pigment as it is brought to life in every artwork.
